Dear parents,

Kindly be reminded that if you have not yet submitted all relevant supporting documents for your child's participation in Physical Education (Solemn Declaration, Individual Student Health Card, Certificate of Dermatological Examination) you will need to do so no later than **September 30th, 2021**. Please send them in an envelope via your child to **International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme Secretary** Mr. E. Georgoulas, office 208, IB DP Building. Alternatively, you may fax them (210 6756762) or email them (egeorgoulas@athenscollege.edu.gr). If you opt to send them either by fax or electronically, you will still need to **submit the original Individual Student Health Card** to Mr. E. Georgoulas (Office 208, IB DP Building) via your child. Please note that electronic registration of the student must be complete prior to submitting any of the above documents.

In accordance with current legislation regarding student participation in Physical Education and all school related sports activities, it is obligatory that you submit the **Individual Student Health Card (Ατομικό Δελτίο Υγείας Μαθητή Α.Δ.Υ.Μ.)**. The Student Health Card is typically submitted during registration for A' Lykeion and is valid for three (3) years. In the event that any health issues or risk factors arise during the course of those three years, parents are obliged to immediately submit a new, updated Health Card to the school.

Parents of children with chronic diseases, severe allergies, or other serious health issues must also submit an **additional** certificate from the child's attending physician outlining specific instructions on how the School should deal with an in-school emergency related to said disease, allergy or other serious health issue.

The following Medical specialists can fill in and sign the Individual Student Health Card.:

- Paediatricians for students up to the age of sixteen
- Pathologists or cardiologists for students above the age of sixteen
- Exception to the above: students being monitored by special pediatric units for disease-specific illnesses or in instances where the student's biological maturity corresponds to childhood, then his/her pediatrician may sign the Individual Health Card

More specifically:

A) For swimming lessons:

In order for students to participate in the swimming lessons, parents need to provide the school with a certificate of dermatological examination at the beginning of each school year. The certificate is valid for one (1) academic year, and if it is not submitted by the beginning of the school year, the student may not actively participate in the class. Medical

specialists who can complete and sign the certificate of dermatological examination are dermatologists, paediatricians or pathologists.

B) For participation in the School's Representative Teams

In order for a student to take part in the School's Representative Teams and participate in the various championships (Interschool Championships, Private School Championships, Panhellenic School Championships, etc.), parents need to provide the school with a Medical Certificate at the beginning of each school year. The Certificate is valid for one (1) academic year. Medical specialists that can complete and sign the Medical Certificate for students up to the age of sixteen (16) are paediatricians. For students above the age of sixteen (16), pathologists or cardiologists may complete the Medical Certificate. Any Medical Certificates signed by physicians of other specialities will NOT be accepted.

Overall:

For A' Lykeion students we require:

Student's Individual Health Card (Ατομικό Δελτίο Υγείας)

For the General High School and the IB DP we require:

- For swimming lessons: Certificate of Dermatological Examination
- For participation in the Representative Teams: Medical Certificate

Kindly note that according to law 79942/ΓΔ4/2019 Υ.Α. (ΦΕΚ Β' 2005./τΒ) (article 9), overdue registration is completed upon the approval of the relevant Director of Secondary Education up to ten (10) days after the start of classes. **Student absences are counted in full from the first day of classes up until the overdue registration is completed.***

As of October 1st 2021 students will not be allowed to participate in their Physical Education class if they have not submitted all appropriate supporting documents.
