Oxford Royale Academy Summer School

Abstract: Offers summer courses for ages 13-18 in a range of subjects and sub-programmes such as Law, Enterprise, Leadership, Medicine, Engineering, Film,

Computer Science, Mathematics, and more. The Broadening Horizons course offers students aged 16-18 the opportunity to live and study in a college of the University of Oxford or Yarnton Manor. Students choose three subjects from the 23 options available, allowing them to pursue areas of interest or to try out something new. Attendees on the Broadening Horizons programme receive more than 20 hours of tuition per week. Students select two unique morning options (one from List A and one from List B) and an Afternoon Workshop class. Students follow all of their classes for two weeks – attendees on the four-week programme are asked to select two options from each list.

- Consistently achieve A*/A grades in at least 50% of their subjects
- Have academic achievements in the top 5% of the national average
- Have academic achievements which are in the top 10% of their school average or are recognized as gifted relative to those in their own year group
- Have one or more abilities developed to a level significantly ahead of their year group (or with the potential to develop those abilities)
- Hold an approved English Language qualification
